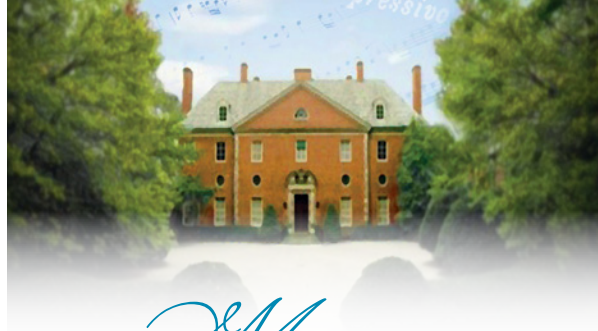

Mozart for the Voice

Wolfgang Amadeus Mozart's *Notturmi* for vocal trio and clarinets, are among the composer's rarely heard gems. Sopranos **Paola Ines Gonzalez** and **Fotina Naumenko** and baritone **Stephen Michael Hanna** will be joined by clarinetists **Ixi Chen** and **Jeff O'Flynn** to perform these rarely heard songs.

These will be followed by four Mozart concert arias: *Rivolgete a lui lo sguardo*, K. 584, *Ch' Io mi scordi di te*, K. 505, *Per pietà, non ricercate*, K420 and *Vorrei spiegarvi, o Dio*, K. 418.

In the second half, tenor **Pedro Andre Arroyo** and **Ms. Gonzalez**, **Ms. Naumenko** and **Mr. Hanna** will star in *The Impresario*, Mozart's delightful satire of singers and singing, sung in English.

Danny White is the music director for the program.

Paris: City Of Light

In the first half, a two-piano version of **Camille Saint-Saëns' Carnival of the Animals** will be played by pianists **Frank Weinstock** and **Rachel Kay Zapata**, with **Kimberly Daniel de Acha** reading humorous verses especially created to accompany this music

The program will also include a bouquet of French melodies by Debussy and Ravel performed by soprano **Annalise Dzwonczyk** and mezzo-soprano **Ryu Kyung Kim** with harpist **Elizabeth Motter**.

The second half of the program will include duets and arias by **Camille Saint-Saëns**, **Massenet**, **Paladilhe**, **Fauré** and **Berlioz**, providing a perfect finish to our 2015-2016 series.
